**Greenville Health Authority's** board of trustees awarded more than \$5.8 million in its **Healthy Greenville Grants** to 11 Greenville County nonprofits on Nov. 16.

All the grants will be distributed over a one-to-three-year period. The 2022 recipients included:

- **Center for Developmental Services** – \$553,750 over three years
- **FAVOR Upstate** – \$1,374,291, over three years
- **Girls on the Run Upstate SC** – \$45,000 over three years
- **Greenville County First Steps** – \$600,000 over three years
- **NOTUS Sports** – \$750,000 over two years
- **Pendleton Place** – \$200,000 over three years

- **Safe Harbor** – \$500,000 over two years
- **Soteria Community Development Corporation** – \$7,220 one-year grant
- **Unity Health on Main** – \$1,389,740 over three years
- **University of South Carolina Educational Foundation** – \$247,029 over three years
- **YMCA of Greenville** – \$189,000 one-year grant

“The goal of the Healthy Greenville Grant Initiatives is to make Greenville County the healthiest county we can become by funding health-related care, health research and health education that improves the health of Greenville County residents,” said Greenville Health Authority President Phillip Liston. “We are proud that in less than six years, the Greenville Health Authority has awarded more than \$28 million in grants to 65 Greenville County organizations – a total of 102 grant awards.”
